Home Banking Security Update

Many of you already have noticed the Security Update for Home Banking which took place on June 14, 2007. This update is required by the National Credit Union Administration and is commonplace for most internet applications where confidential information may be accessed.



The Security Update is a one time process and should only take a few minutes of your time.

Here is how it works:

Step 1- Select a security image

Step 2- Select the type of challenge you would like to answer when accessing Home Banking from an UNAUTHORIZED computer.

Step 3- Answer the challenge question information.

Step 4- Select whether or not to authorize the computer you are working on currently. (Tip: Authorize all PC's which only you have access to. Generally, do not authorize those in public places- for example, the Public Library).

Frequently Asked Questions:

How will this affect me next time I log in?

The ONLY change you will see is that your security image will show before you enter your password on an AUTHORIZED computer.

Why do I have to pick a Security Image?

If you see the security image you picked, then you are at the true LPCCU Home Banking Website. If you do not see the security image you picked, you may be at a spoof website and should call the credit union immediately.

Why do I have to pick Challenge Questions?

Challenge questions increase the protection on your account when you log in from an UNAUTHORIZED computer by asking you questions only you would know the answers to.

We take your confidential information very seriously here at LPCCU. So it is important to us to keep up with the latest technology to ensure your personal information stays personal. Please feel free to call us with any questions you may have regarding this security update.
